
Why you should compare procedure costs

Different hospitals, clinics and offices charge different amounts for the same type of care. Our Find Care tool shows you what you can expect to pay for care at each location, based on your plan benefits. This helps you make the best choice for both your health and your wallet.

How to search for procedure costs

Start your search by logging in to your member account at <u>members.bcidaho.com</u>. From there, select **Find Care.** Use the Find Care tool to search for doctors, hospitals, clinics and services.

You can also use the Blue Cross of Idaho member app to look up procedure costs. Just log in to the app and select *Find Care*.




What you'll see

When you search for procedures and services – like MRIs, ultrasounds, physical therapy or tests – the Find Care tool will show you what you can expect to pay for each search result in the Your Estimated Costs column.¹ This amount is based on your plan benefits. Because you'll be logged in to your member account, your results will only show you in-network providers. The search results will also show you the address, contact information and patient reviews for each location. You can use the filter and sorting options to refine the results.

When you select a provider from the search results, you'll be taken to a page that shows you a wealth of details. What may be most important for you is the Estimated Procedure Cost category at the top of the page. Here, you'll see a breakdown of the costs for the procedure from this provider – what your plan would pay, plus what you would pay as a copay, deductible and coinsurance.¹



¹Please note that this estimated cost depends on your plan and what you may have already paid toward care during the plan year.

What can I search for?

The Find Care tool lets you search healthcare providers, hospitals and medical services.

Where does Blue Cross of Idaho get information about the costs of procedures?

We use 12 months of claims data plus claims data from other Blue Cross Blue Shield plans to give you estimates for the cost of care.

Why are some facilities and providers more expensive than others?

Costs vary between healthcare providers based on many factors, from the facility where they practice to the tests they order. Hospitals and clinics may charge different prices for hospital stays, doctor's fees, lab work and anesthesia that can add up for services like knee replacements, CT scans and mammograms.

How do I know which hospital or provider to choose?

The Find Care tool lets you sort by cost, location and type of care. Keep in mind that Blue Cross of Idaho only contracts with healthcare providers who meet the high standards of their area of focus. If you select a provider or facility with a low cost, you can still expect highly effective care.
