## Cost Relief for Specialty Drugs





## The Cost Relief program helps you save with a \$0 copay on certain specialty drugs.

Specialty drugs are an important part of care for many people, but they often come with a high cost. Blue Cross of Idaho Rx has teamed up with our pharmacy partner, CarelonRx, to offer you a new way to save. By connecting you with drug manufacturer copay-assistance programs, the program can help keep costs down with a \$0 copay on eligible specialty drugs.



Cost Relief works with manufacturers to get copay card assistance and manages enrollment and renewals for you.<sup>2</sup> Even if there is no copay assistance available for your specialty drug, your cost will be \$0 out of pocket.

<sup>1.</sup> Members must enroll in the program and cost share could vary dependent on enrollment. Members who do not wish to participate in this program can opt out and will be responsible for the full amount of the cost share for their specialty drug. This will increase the cost of specialty drugs by 30-45%. Cost shares for any drug do not count towards plan deductible nor out-of-pocket limit.
